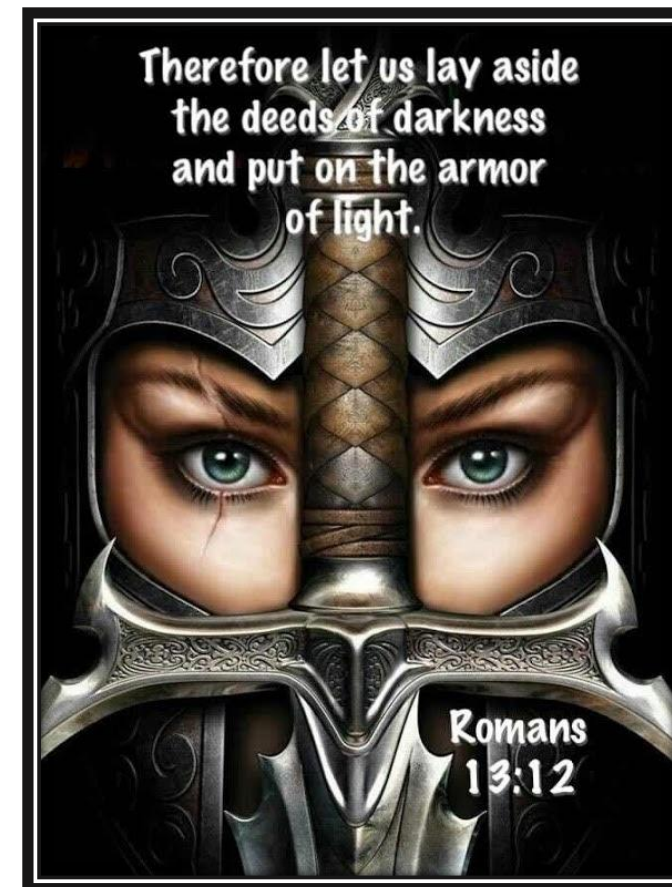
- The September communion side offering goes to The Least of These Ministries.
