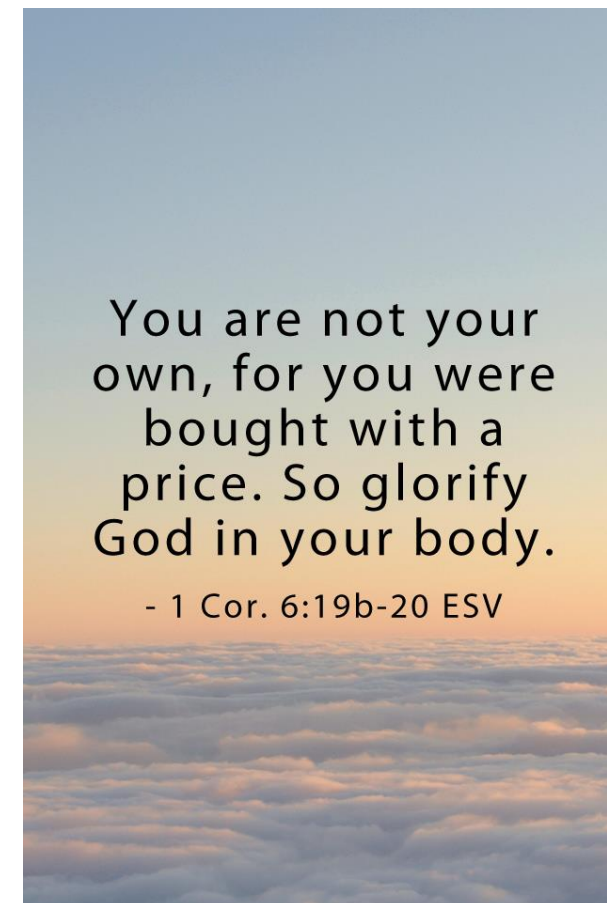
TCUMC NEWS
